E. R. MESSAGE

It was 110 years ago this month that a group assembled in the office of Dr. O.L. Daniel to elect officers and organize an Elks Lodge here in Murphysboro. Over the years, Lodge 572 has grown from those humble beginnings into what it is today. I like to think that if the founders of our Lodge could see it today, it would make them genuinely proud. It's a new fiscal year... with a new board of officers... but the goals and mission remain the same...let's get to work.


