NOTE FROM LODGE SECRETARY

If you are in possession of vour 2013-2014. Membership Card (and Red Key Card), Thank You for taking care of vour dues obligation! A reminder notice has been mailed to those whose dues are delinquent. Being delinquent also means that in our particular Lodge, Club Privileges are no longer available after June 1st (Ordering food / drinks; or participating in activities.) Lodge meetings are also not open to unpaid members, at any time after April 1. (The BPO Elks Lodge year, nation-wide, always starts on April 1, so that is likewise, always the official beginning date when delinquency status begins. Many Lodges, around the country, also deny Club privileges or entry to delinquents, beginning April 1.) This data is simply FYI.

- 3. Help your candidate fill out & sign their part. Submit to Secretary, with \$35 Initiation Fee.
