It is again that time of year when <u>MVS</u> (Most Valuable Student) Scholarship Applications are available to High School Seniors. No Elk affiliation is required to apply for one of these awards, of which there are 500 Nationally. Strong Academics; Strong ACT or SAT Test Scores; active Leadership Roles; Community Service; and economic need are the criteria for selection. For Seniors who are children or grandchildren of active Elk Members, there are the <u>LEGACY</u> Scholarship awards (250, Nationally). Deadline for MVS is Dec. 5, 2014, and for the Legacy, January 30, 2015. Applications must be downloaded from the National Foundation Website: <u>www.elks.org/enf/scholars/mvs.cfm</u> for the MVS, and <u>www.elks.org/enf/scholars</u> for the Legacy. <u>Full details</u> require more space than this newsletter allows, but <u>are</u> available on these websites.


