ENF BEACON GRANT TO ASSIST NEEDY VETERANS AT HAVEN

We are pleased to announce that the Elks National Foundation (ENF) has approved our Beacon Grant application for 2014 -2015. This \$2,000 grant will be used to prepare and serve 11:00 a.m. meals, the 3rd Tuesday of each month (thru July, 2015), at the Haven, which is the area Veterans' Day Lodge, located on Crab Orchard Lake. These meals will be for needy / disabled veterans, who come to the Haven on 3rd Tuesdays, for counseling and support services. This monthly gathering of some 30 or more veterans compose what is known as the MHICM group. We have Elk leadership and coordination in place for these meals, but need an additional two or more Elks to sign up and assist, each month. If you want to volunteer, please let the E.
