LODGE #572 MEMBERS SHOW GREAT SUPPORT FOR MORTGAGE REDUCTION WITH OPTIONAL DONATIONS SUBMITTED WITH DUES PAYMENTS!!!!

"WOW" would perhaps be the appropriate word to use in analyzing how much your Lodge has received to date (4/29/2015) in extra Mortgage Reduction donations submitted by YOU, our members, with your 2015 - 2016 dues payments. A total of \$2,868.75 has been contributed by 152 of the 520 members paid, as of the above-mentioned date! This amount will be forwarded immediately, to our lending institution. And, as this payment will reduce interest, your generosity will grow even larger.

We have yet to receive dues payments from 113 of our members (17.88%). We anticipate that some <u>additional donations</u> will show up as these dues arrive at the Lodge. A second total will then be calculated (probably in December), and applied to our Mortgage. As these figures show such <u>tremendous member support</u>, we wanted to share them with our entire membership. To Mortgage Reduction donors, ALL, **THANK YOU!!**
