These tabs are high-grade aluminum and are quite valuable for being recycled into such areas as surgical equipment for the medical field. So, how does saving these small tabs help veterans? Each time Lodge #572 Officers go to Springfield for state, IEA meetings, we (along with Officers and Members of Lodges throughout the state) take these tabs that have been collected in the Club Room, and submit them to Veterans Service Volunteers, who then use proceeds from the tab sales, to assist veterans.
