LODGE #572 DOES IT AGAIN....A MEMBERSHIP GAIN!!

Starting the 2016 - 2017 year with 652 members, it appears we will **end the year at 659, for a gain of + 7.** Although our deceased member total unfortunately rose to 16, we **initiated 42**, affiliated 3, and reinstated 8, for a total of 53 additions. Added to the 16 deceased, were 9 others who transferred out or were dropped for other reasons - resulting in a total deduction of 25. At publication, it appears 21 will be dropped for non-payment of dues. Thus, our <u>anticipated ending number of 659</u>. Top recruiters for the year were: Jay Ziegler with 6; Bobby D. Skidmore and Merle Evans at 5 each; Roger Phoenix, Larry Elliott, and Steve Schemonia at 3. Congratulations, and furthermore, thanks to **ALL** who helped in so many ways, in the growth of our Lodge! Great Job, Everyone.

ELKS NATIONAL FOUNDATION GOALS REACHED BY LODGE #572

Once again, we are please to report that our Lodge has reached the Grand Exalted Ruler's ENF goal of \$4.65 per-capita, and our State President's goal of \$5.50 per-capita for this Lodge year! As a result, we now qualify for \$3,500 in Gratitude and IEA grants, in addition to our \$2,000.00 Beacon Grant, which is funding Veteran meals at the Haven. In addition to individual contributions made directly to the ENF, by some of our members, the bulk of our total contribution currently comes from our Benefit Shooting Matches. Our volunteers worked hard this year, and many of you, our members, participated in or attended these ENF fund raisers. **Thanks, everyone.....job well done**, to help your Elk's Lodge provide services and programs to our communities!





