Members All - our annual "Scholarship Nut Sale" is drawing near! We received the order form from the Thames Nut Company on Oct. 14th,

and placed our order on Oct. 17th. Upon speaking with the Thames representative, I was advised that the nuts were still somewhat green and not quite ready for harvest. Thus, our order will not arrive until the first or second week of November. (In past years, we have received our orders anywhere from November 4th - 10th.

I do have one item of concern: Thames is advising that due to rising costs and losing about 30% of their crop due to the hurricanes this year, the cost of the pecans have gone up. Therefore, we will be forced to adjust our prices accordingly. The nuts most affected are the Pecan Halves, Pecan Pieces, and Cashews. We will need to ask \$11 per bag on these 3 items, this year. All the other nuts will be able to remain at last year's price of \$10 (i.le., Praline and Chocolate Pecans, and the Mixed Nuts).

Forms are ready in the Club Room, for anyone who would like to preorder and have their order ready when the nuts arrive, or for all those who like to take them to work and sell to their co-workers. Also, as in past years, if there is anyone who is unable to come to the Lodge to make their purchase, I will be more than happy to bring them out to you. Please feel free to call me!

Thank you all for your continued support in this worthy endeavor, which funds a scholarship for a "C" student (Senior) at Murphysboro High School.
