LODGE #572 PROUD TO ACHIEVE MEMBERSHIP GAIN!

For year 2017 - 2018, your Lodge has managed to increase its membership to 664, as of April 1, 2018. Initiations, Reinstatements, and Transfers in totaled 41. Deaths, Transfers Out, and Absolute Dimits resulted in a loss of 18. This gain of 23 was unfortunately offset by our 21 members who were dropped for Non-Payment of Dues, on March 31st. A modest gain - yes, but a GAIN, non the less! And, 664 is the largest, year's starting number of members in the History of the Murphysboro Lodge!

NUT SALES FOR LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP AT MHS

Lodge Members All - Still on hand are: Walnuts, Almonds, Cashews, Praline Pecans, and Pecan Pieces. All selections are now \$10.00 (Some, originally, were \$11.00). We are not sure, exactly, as to the reason, but this year's sales were slower, and much below all prior years. Also, to receive adequate shipping discounts and keep our prices stable, the Lodge has been ordering a fall shipment, usually running between \$9,000.00 - \$11,000.00 (A huge capital outlay, at a time when Lodge funds are trending lower, in the second half of the Lodge year). As a result of these situations, we regret to report that the Lodge will not continue our Holiday Nuts Sales, this coming fall. So, this is, in essence, your final chance to purchase and enjoy these outstanding items from the Thames Pecan Co., in Georgia. (To all of you who have, and do look forward to purchases through this fund-raising effort, we sincerely apologize for the discontinuance - but we have to deal with both economic and time realities involved in the program.)

As to our Local Scholarship, for a "C Student" at Murphysboro High School, we will continue said scholarship - but funded through other Elk projects or Events!
