I have had several Elks come up and offer to serve on a couple of new committees - one of which has already begun producing results. So, if you have an idea of something you would like to see started at the Lodge, please let me know.

Upcoming events: <u>Cinco De Mayo</u> will be on Sunday, May 5th (See Article). Then, we will be hosting our annual <u>Mothers Day Brunch</u> on Sunday, May 12. We are still looking for a few volunteers to prepare the food that morning! And, <u>don't forget</u> about our Weekly, Monthly, and Queen of Hearts Drawings! Along those lines, we are looking for fundraising ideas - in particular, an event to purchase a <u>portable defibulator for the Lodge!</u> Speaking of safety - keep an eye out for upcoming <u>fire extinguisher training</u>. This training will be given by Murphysboro Fire Dept. Chief, Steve McBride, who is in the process of setting a date and time, as well as gather everything needed to put on the class.

As we all know, the Elks National Foundation (ENF) is often referred to as "The Great Heart of Elkdom," in that it supports so much of what the we do, both nationally, and in our communities. Thanks to P.E.R., Darcie Hastings, for her hard work on securing 2019-2020 ENF Grants for our Lodge. (Recall that this past year, we continued meals at the Haven; purchased carpet for the Liberty Theater; purchased items for the "Restore Network," foster family support organization; donated to Crimson Express at MHS; supported Scouts and 4-H; and more - all through ENF Grants!) Already, this year, we have been approved for a Promise Grant, to be used for educational support to atrisk & needy children in our community (\$2,500); and a Freedom Grant (New!), to assist area Veterans and their families, who need support, with basic living needs (\$2,000). Applications in progress, or to follow later this year, are: Spotlight Grant (\$2,000); Continuation of Beacon Grant, for Haven Veterans Center (\$2,500); Gratitude Grant (\$2,000); and IEA / State President's ENF Goal Grant (\$1,500). Add to this ENF Grant total of \$12,500, our new VAVS sponsoring Lodge appointment - making available, indirectly, some \$3,600 yearly, for use with needy Veterans in our area......A total of around \$16,000 for Lodge #572 to use in our community! So, when we encourage our members to contribute to the ENF, or participate in our Shooting Matches, to reach our Lodge per-capita total of around \$3,700......think about our return on that investment!

Also, let me thank Jim Ferguson, Buddy Ferguson, Ted Ferguson, and Bruce Francis, for their hard work on cleaning up the North (Front) side of the Lodge, and removing old trees & bushed that had grown into the building (take as glance when you drive by). And, for hopping forth as our Easter Bunny this year, member Jeff Eliasen (a.k.a., our lone, male Bartender).

Don't forget about <u>Sundays</u> at the Lodge. Starting on May 12th, we will return to 2:00 p.m. openings, until NFL football season begins again. We always have Baseball and Golf on the T. V.s, so come down and visit with fellow members, while cheering on your favorite team or golfer.
