We did it! Through both the generosity of Lodge #572 individuals sending in contributions to the Elks National Foundation, and mainly the HARD WORK and TIME given by our dedicated VOLUNTEERS at our 4 ENF Benefit Shooting Matches, held in January and February, we have met the required \$5.50 per member (State President's Goal) for 2019 - 2020. Therefore, again in 2020 - 2021, we are qualified to apply for / receive all National & State Grants. This past year, these grants brought back some \$11,000 into our Community. MESSAGE FROM LODGE SECRETARY

Dues statements for 2020 - 2021 will be arriving soon (They are running a little behind last year's schedule, due to a variety of circumstances.). As a result of a Liability Insurance increase on the Grand Lodge's nation-wide policy, a \$2 increase has been assessed on all Lodges for G.L. per-capita. Please note that there has been NO INCREASE of your local Lodge dues. So, if you are at the Lodge, or want to go ahead & send in your dues payment (P. O box 787, to attention of Lodge Secretary), they are: Regular Members = \$70.25; Life Members = \$33.25. And, as last year, if you want to send in a little extra, it will stay at home - going to our Building Maintenance Fund. (Note - if you pay just before/during the time when notices are sent - there might well be a crossing in the mail, so we apologize, in advance!). Once notices are sent out, it is "Crunch Time" for the Secretary's Office - so, you might not receive your new cards before Key Card Reader is changed on April 1 (You might need to use door buzzer for a few days.) Also, please recall that during the month of APRIL, members will have a "Pass" on not being on the CLMS Delinquent List, on the 1st day of month, as is required all other months, to be eligible for any Raffles or Drawings, held during that particular month. With some 670 members, we are a large Lodge, so we ask your patience/ cooperation in getting member/spouse key cards out to you. Thanks in advance, everyone!
