Members All,

As you may by now know, we have been able to reopen our doors thanks to the time and dedication of many volunteers. I am deeply grateful to all who have volunteered to assist in keeping our organization afloat over these last few months; however, we are not quite out of the woods yet.

If you were not aware, the Lodge did not qualify for any of the small business grants that were awarded to struggling businesses during this time due to the non-profit nature of our organization. Though we have had an incredible amount of support from our members, the Lodge is still feeling the financial burden of the pandemic. With the intent of supporting the Lodge, we will begin selling raffle tickets in the later part of August. These raffle tickets will be ten dollars each, for a chance at winning one of three cash prizes: \$500, \$250, \$100. The tickets can be sold to anyone as long as they are sold by a member of the Lodge, and the drawing will take place in the early part of September. Keep an eye out to buy your ticket and learn more about the drawing!

Business aside, there has been more good news for Lodge #572 in the month of July! We have received a plaque from Grand Lodge in recognition of the Murphysboro Lodge website, www.elks572.org, being among five other lodges as the top tier Elks websites in the country! Make sure to congratulate/thank Steve Zak for his excellent work on maintaining the site. I can not recommend visiting it enough! However, with the Lodge now open, we must return to enforcing the regulations of our Order, along with our own House rules which require that members must <u>not</u> be on the CLIMS delinquent list, on the first day of the month, in order to participate in any drawing that month. Each dues payment received reduces the financial burden of the Lodge, as National, State, and District per capita for all members are paid for in April. We appreciate your assistance in this matter!

Finally, I would like to especially thank all the employees who volunteered their shifts to help the Lodge through the last month. Understandably, they will not be able to continue volunteering their time in the month of August. Other than this change, the month of August will continue with the same operation strategy as we implemented in July.
