Examples of areas where point are earned: Annual Reports to Grand Lodge; Americanism activities; Membership gains; ENF goal attainment; ENF Grants written for and awarded; Hoop Shoot participation; Veteran Activities; Drug Awareness activities; Youth activities; and many more!

We hope that as a member of Murphysboro #572, you are pleased that <u>your home Lodge</u> is an *All-American Lodge*! For assembling the data needed to submit for this award, and for working to help plan extra events and activities, thanks to PER / Trustee, Darcie Hastings. And, additionally, thanks to Dennis Bierman (DuQuoin Lodge #884), State Lodge Activities Chairman, for encouraging our Lodge to attempt achieving this Honor!
