Members All,

As always, we continue to remain very busy at the Lodge and Club, with various events. Thank you to *All* who <u>helped</u> with an event or two, or a <u>ttended</u>, to help make them a success. Please make sure to watch for more Lodge events in the upcoming weeks.

As a reminder - we do fundraisers throughout the year, to our state major project, the Illinois Elks Children's Care Corporation; the Elks National Foundation (ENF), and other programs. When we reach our goals for the ENF (\$5.50 per-capita, based on our beginning membership number on April 1), we then qualify for Grant Money from the Foundation, along with some from the Illinois Elks Association. Generally, we are talking here about some \$10,000 or more! With that money, we then support and donate to Veterans, Youth, and various Groups and Organizations throughout the community and our Lodge's designated geographic area. Other events that we hold allow us to fund our Lodge accounts and be prepared for unforeseen breakdowns of equipment and / or attend to repairs on our Lodge building. I am very proud to say that we have not had to borrow any funds for repairs and such. In the last 4 to 5 years, we have continued to grow our accounts which have allowed us to maintain our Lodge. Our Building Fund, alone, has enabled us to replace the entire refrigeration system that serves our walk-in cooler; purchase a new beer cooler; add / replace / repair kitchen equipment; and totally replace the original heating and cooling unit in the Hall, with a modern mini-split system. These examples are only a few of the specific purchases and upgrades made possible as a result of our building maintenance fund - which, indeed, many of you have kindly donated to, in conjunction with your yearly dues payments!

The above being said, if you have not visited the Lodge in a while - come down and see us. Bring in your family or a guest for dinner, or just a relaxing visit. Enjoy a conversation with some fellow Elks! If it is an area of interest to you, maybe step into our totally private game room.

Now - in closing, if you have an idea for an event, or just a general question, look for one of your Lodge Officers and they will either answer it, get an answer to you, or direct you to someone who will be able to do so. Again, my THANKS to everyone who continues to support Murphysboro Elk's Lodge #572!
